It looks like the author took some pride in it.</p>
<p>4 <i>Above & Beyond</i></p>	<p>The entire story is related to the assigned topic and allows the reader to understand much more about the topic.</p>	<p>The story contains many creative details and/or descriptions that are original; illustrations are detailed, attractive, creative and relate to the text on the page.</p>	<p>There is an appropriate amount of dialogue to bring the characters to life and it is always clear which character is speaking.</p>	<p>There are no spelling or punctuation errors in the final draft. It looks like the author took great pride in it.</p>
